Scope & Characteristics	<ul> <li>Countywide or larger scope programs</li> <li>Impact on complex issues and/or multiple geographic areas</li> <li>Organizations with strong track record of effectiveness</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Limited size and scope programs</li> <li>Serve specific community or neighborhood</li> <li>Smaller organizations</li> <li>First-time Community Impact applicants</li> </ul>
Application & Reporting	<ul> <li>Comprehensive application form</li> <li>Capacity to track and measure results annually</li> <li>Higher expectations for outcome measurement</li> </ul>	Shorter application form     Measurable results encouraged

## 5-Year Funding Limit Extension

✓ Current consecutive funding policy is under review

✓ The CFMC board has approved a one year extension to this policy to complete a thorough review

2012 2017 - One 2013 Year Extension 2016 2014 2015

✓ All organizations are eligible in 2017

- You have any questions at all it's better to call far ahead of the deadline!

## Final Evaluation Reports

- 11 month grant cycle
- Evaluation available online
- Previous answers available:
  - **Program Description**
  - **Expected Outcomes**
  - **Expected Measurable Results**
  - **Data Collection**
- Use application to frame final results
