Grant Amount	\$12,001–\$50,000	\$5,000–\$12,000
Application Deadlines	1st Friday in February and August	1st Friday in March and September
Scope & Characteristics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Countywide or larger scope programs • Impact on complex issues and/or multiple geographic areas • Organizations with strong track record of effectiveness 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Limited size and scope programs • Serve specific community or neighborhood • Smaller organizations • First-time Community Impact applicants
Application & Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comprehensive application form • Capacity to track and measure results annually • Higher expectations for outcome measurement 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Shorter application form • Measurable results encouraged
Review	Grant committee review	Staff review
Decision	Within 5 months	Within 3.5 months

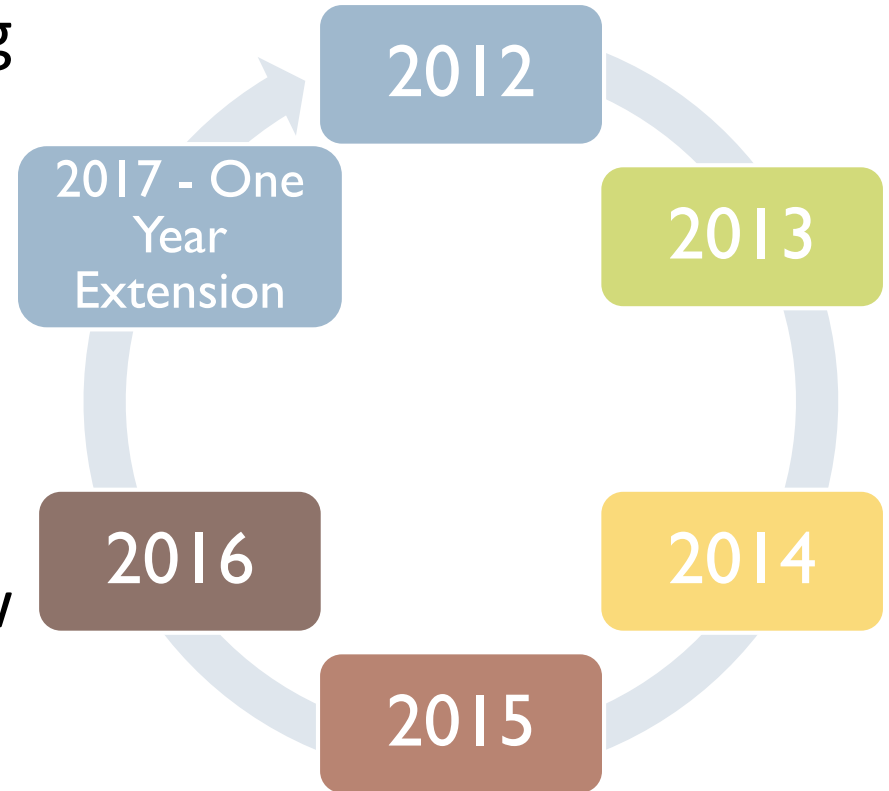
Grant Committee

- Thorough process
- 8-9 members

5-Year Funding Limit Extension

- ✓ Current consecutive funding policy is under review
- ✓ The CFMC board has approved a one year extension to this policy to complete a thorough review
- ✓ All organizations are eligible in 2017



Contact your program officer ASAP if...

- You are applying with a fiscal sponsor or as a part of a collaborative
- You don't think you need to submit all the required forms
- You question your eligibility
- You don't understand our guidelines
- You can't measure your impact
- You have any questions at all – it's better to call far ahead of the deadline!



Final Evaluation Reports

- 11 month grant cycle
- Evaluation available online
- Previous answers available:
 - Program Description
 - Expected Outcomes
 - Expected Measurable Results
 - Data Collection
- Use application to frame final results



Online Grants Manager

- ✓ Read the Overview Guide at cfmco.org/apply
- ✓ Add “administrator@grantinterface.com” to your safe contacts
- ✓ Bookmark url – access grant applications and reports in one place
- ✓ Submit your application before 5 PM (earlier, if possible)



Online Grants Manager

- ✓ Review the application questions first
- ✓ Prepare all application documents before submission
- ✓ Two years of financial statements
 - Statement of Activities and P&L
- ✓ Updated contact information
 - Auto reminders, evaluation report
- ✓ Contact us as soon as your contact information changes
