Southern Monterey County Foundation

The Southern Monterey County Foundation (SMCF) helps donors invest their contributions close to home and improve the quality of life for area residents. The SMCF is an affiliate of the Community Foundation for Monterey County (CFMC). A local advisory board provides oversight, defines grantmaking priorities and raises funds that are distributed to community organizations serving Southern Monterey County. The CFMC provides financial stewardship, administrative support and the services of a fully accredited community foundation that is held to rigorous National Standards. The CFMC's charitable assets are invested in a diversified portfolio. The trailing five-year average annual return is 5.1% through December 31, 2015. Administration fees are 2%.

Neighbors Helping Neighbors

The SMCF provides an opportunity to pool philanthropic resources and strengthen communities from King City to points south. It is governed by an advisory board of residents who have a deep understanding of community needs, appreciation for Southern Monterey County and the tradition of neighbors helping neighbors.

Background

In 2013 leaders from Southern Monterey County expressed an interest in giving back to communities in their geographic area. More than 25 people came together to learn about affiliate funds at the CFMC. Interest and momentum built, leading to the commitment of a \$50,000 seed gift. In 2014 the group chose to create the Southern Monterey County Foundation. Already the SMCF has granted \$37,000 to fifteen projects and programs.
