NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
For the Eleven Months Ended November 30, 2016

Assets

Total Assets through 11/30/2016 are **\$195,385,085** a **7.49%** increase since November 2015, and a **7.54%** increase since December 2015. **(p. 3)**

Charitable Remainder Trusts (CRT) and Charitable Gift Annuities (CGA)

The CRT and CGA funds have been adjusted to reflect the activity and balances per Kaspick & Company and the third party account balances as of December 31, 2015. In November, Marc Rosen established the Marc Rosen CRT with stock valued at \$98,069, with a remainder value of \$10,979. New CRTs and CGAs in 2016 total \$4,683,069, with an estimated remainder value of \$2,152,349. **(p. 3)**

Realized and Unrealized Gains and Losses on Investments

Net year-to-date realized losses were \$1,484,574, and unrealized gains were \$8,790,987, for a total gain of \$7,306,412. **(p. 6)**

Operating Fund

Total revenue was \$102,901 less than the budget, and total expenses were \$114,128 less than the budget. The actual net operating deficit is \$457,308 compared to a budgeted deficit of \$468,535. **(p. 7)**

Note: The Expendable Operating Cash-on-Hand is at 4.0 months, excluding the operating reserve of \$500,000 and the building reserve of \$150,000. **(p. 8)**

Portfolio Performance

The market value of the Long-Term Fund portfolio at 11/30/2016 was \$158,875,750. The year-to-date Total Return for the Long-Term Endowment Portfolio through November 30, 2016 was 6.7% compared to the Policy Index of 6.7%. **(p. 9-12)**

The market value of the Medium-Term Fund portfolio at 11/30/2016 was \$535,706. The quarter-to-date Total Return for the Medium-Term Portfolio through November 30, 2016 was -1.8% compared to the Policy Index of -1.9%. **(p. 13-14)**

The market value of the ESG Fund portfolio at 11/30/2016 was \$875,570. The quarter-to-date Total Return for the ESG Fund Portfolio through November 30, 2016 was -0.4% compared to the Policy Index of -1.1%. **(p. 15-16)**

Special Program Funds

Special Program Funds include: Community Leadership Project, funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation; Pathways to Safety, funded by the ACTION Council of Monterey County; Girl's Health in Girl's Hands, funded by the Claire Giannini Fund, the Peggy and Jack Baskin Foundation, the David and Lucile Packard Foundation and the Monterey Peninsula Foundation; and the Center for Nonprofit Excellence funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation; and the College Futures Foundation program, funded by the College Futures Foundation.

Total Special Program revenue was \$356,529 and total expenses were \$1,094,521. **(p. 5-6)**

Gifts, Pledges, Bequests, Future Funds Greater than \$25,000, and Grants

Total new contributions for the month were \$1,521,028, including \$50,000 from the Colleagues of the Arts to establish the Colleagues of the Arts Endowment Fund; \$30,000 from Dottie Massie for the Monterey County Gives Campaign; stock valued at \$49,695 from George Somero and Amy Anderson for the Amy Anderson and George Somero Fund; \$200,000 from the Landreth Family Foundation for the Landreth Family Fund; stock valued at \$98,069 from Marc Rosen to establish the Marc Rosen CRT, stock valued at \$50,190 from Sarah Patterson Spencer for the Monterey County Gives Campaign; \$100,000 from the Tanimura Family Foundation for the Girls' Health in Girls' Hands Scholarship Fund; \$66,700 from Robert V. Sanford III for the Monterey County Gives Campaign; and stock valued at \$64,647 from Fred Terman and Nan Borreson for The Fred Terman and Nan Borreson Fund. Gifts to the Soberanes Fire Fund totaled \$13,992. The year-to-date gifts to the Soberanes Fire Fund totaled \$936,808, including gifts from Donor Advised funds in the amount of \$64,600, and \$10,000 from the CFMC Opportunity Fund. Total gifts to the Monterey County Gives campaign totaled \$966,660, including gifts from Donor Advised funds in the amount of \$141,750. The year-to-date gifts to the Monterey County Gives Campaign totaled \$1,241,062, including gifts from Donor Advised funds in the amount of \$141,750. **(p. 20-25)**

Grants to agencies for the month totaling \$840,238 were approved and recorded. A complete list of the grants by grantee is included. **(p. 26-27)**

Interfund activity for the month totaled \$197,274. **(p. 25 & 27)**
