How it Works-it's Simple

- You can start your fund with a gift of \$5,000 or more (using cash, appreciated stock, real estate, or other assets).
- A fund is established in your name, in the name of your family or business, or in honor of any person or organization you choose.
- Family members can be named as donor advisors and successor donor advisors.
- You receive tax benefits in the year your gift is made.
- You recommend grants from your fund—working with our professional program staff to support the causes you care about most in Monterey County and beyond.
- We handle all administrative details and issue grants to nonprofits in the name of your fund. (If you prefer, grants can be made anonymously).
- Fund types:
 - Non-endowed You can recommend grants up to the full balance of the fund. Endowed – A percentage of the fund is made available for grantmaking each year.
- You can add to your fund at anytime, or include the fund in a legacy gift through your estate. There is no minimum balance needed to maintain your fund.

Minimum initial contribution:

\$5,000 (non-endowed) \$25,000 (endowed)

Minimum grant amount: \$500

Can be anonymous

Annual Fees:

\$0-\$1 million: 1.25 %

\$2-\$3 million: 1.0 %

> \$3 million: .5 %
