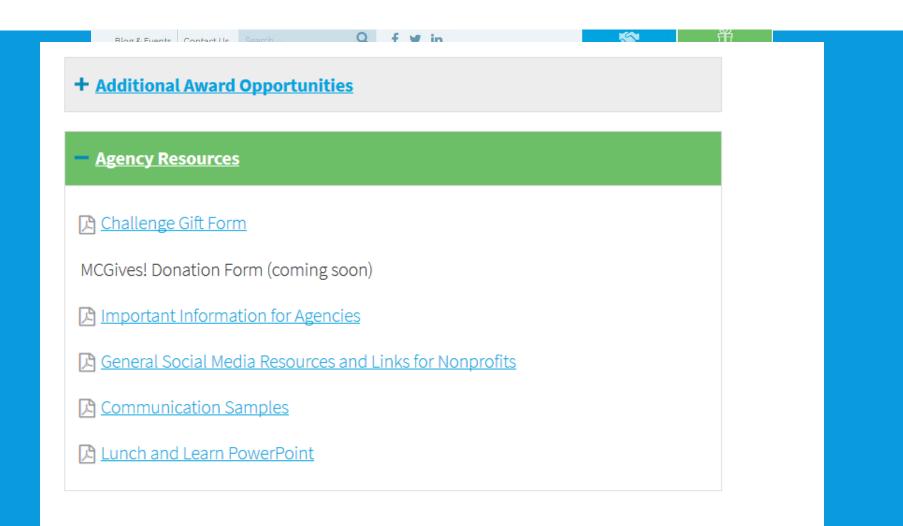

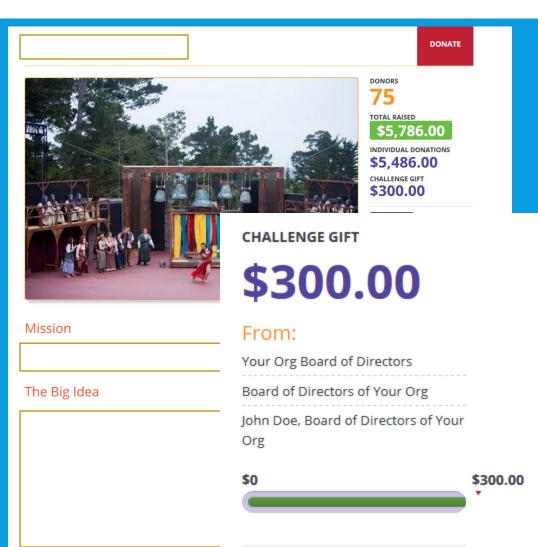

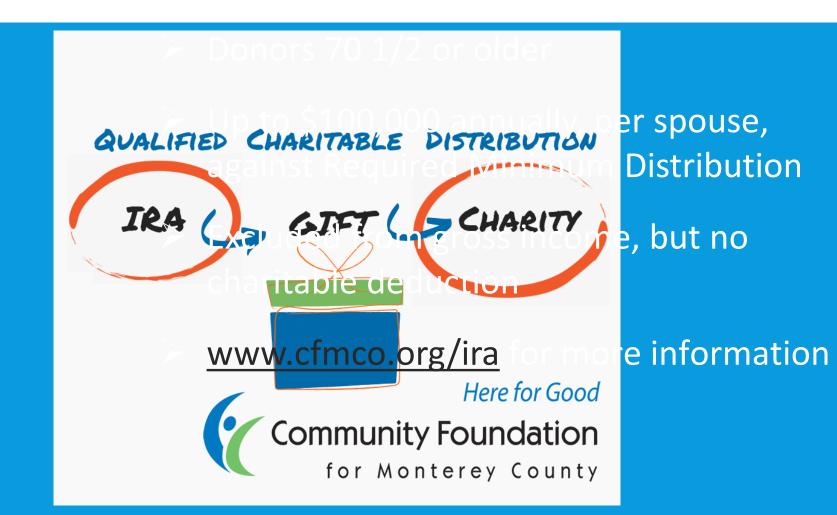

How it Works

If you are 70 1/2 or older, you can make a gift from your IRA account to the Community Foundation. Gifts made from your IRA (up to \$100,000 per year) are not reportable as taxable income and qualify toward your required minimum distribution which can lower your income and taxes. If you are married, your spouse can also make a gift of up to \$100,000 from his or her IRA, for a total of \$200,000.
