The CFMC's Community Impact grants program focuses on the people and places of Monterey County, California, highlighting impact and seeking measurable results. The CFMC supports effective programs that expand access to services and programs for residents throughout Monterey County and address opportunity/ achievement gaps that increase equity (everyone has the same starting point regardless of ethnicity or income). The CFMC conducts periodic reviews of its grantmaking programs. We expect that our grantmaking priorities will evolve in response to community needs. We encourage direct feedback from service providers and community members.

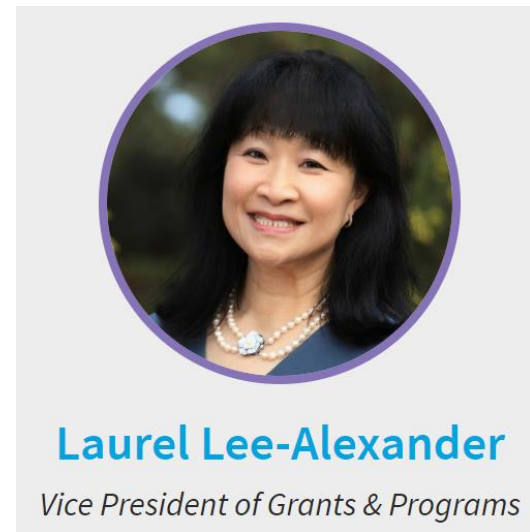
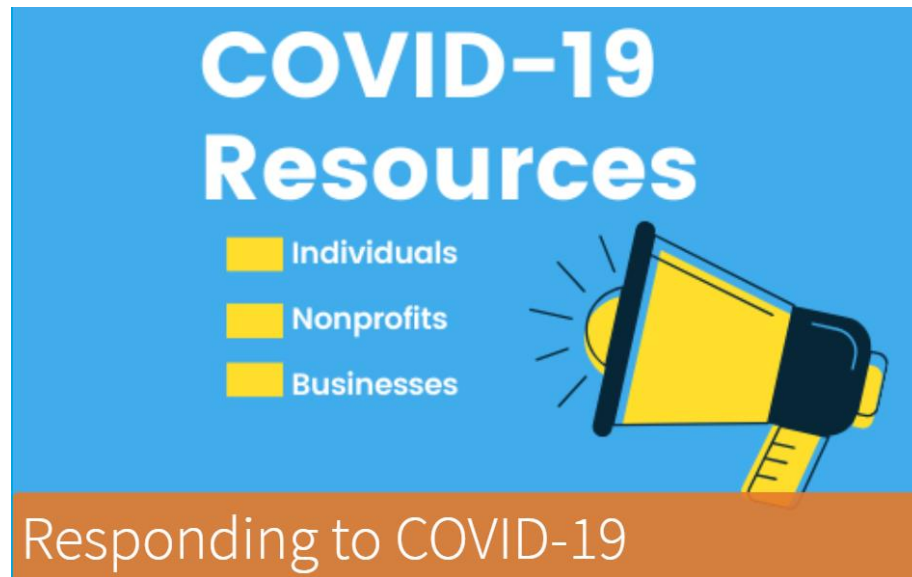

2014 - 2020	2021
Two cycles a year	One cycle
Four application deadlines	One deadline
Two different application forms based on request amount	One full application, shorter renewal application by invitation
One-year (11-mo) grant period	One-year grants, a few two-year grants by invitation

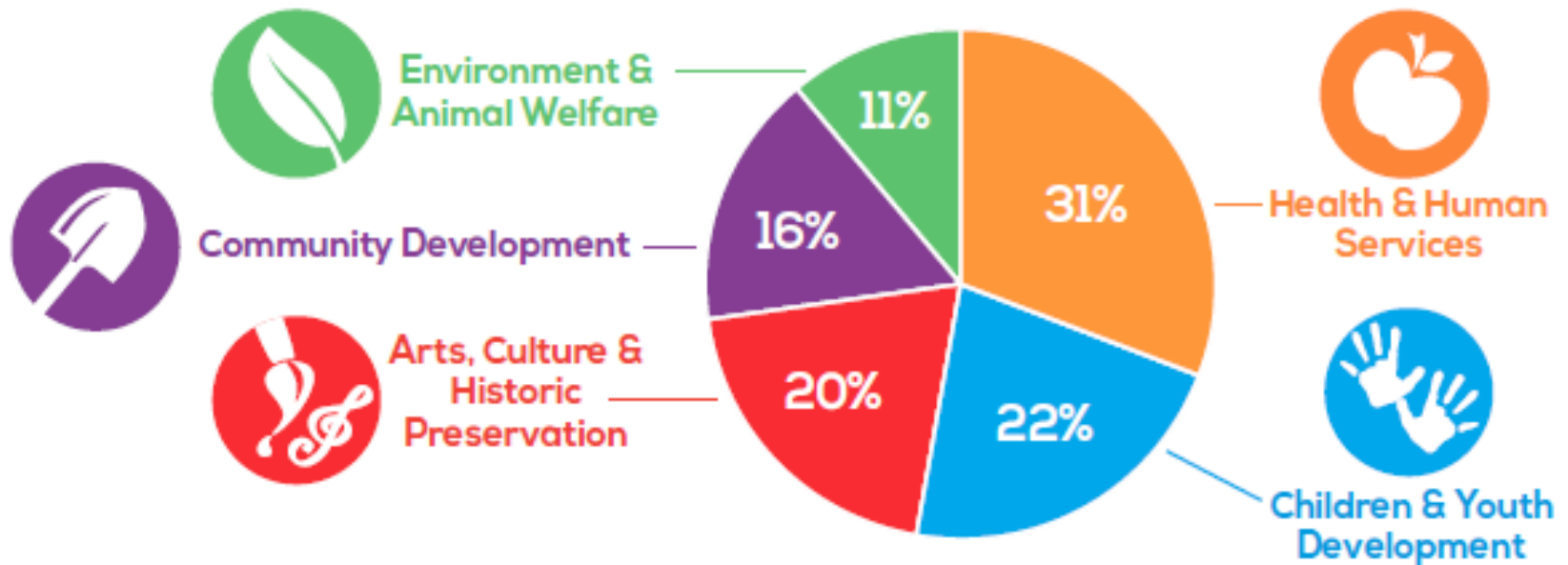
