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COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR MONTEREY COUNTY NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS For the One Month Ended January 31, 2015

Assets

Total Assets through 1/31/2015 are \$178,741,106 a 4.14% increase since January 2014, and a .32% decrease since December 2014. (p. 3)

Charitable Remainder Trusts (CRT) and Charitable Gift Annuities (CGA)

The CRT and CGA funds have been adjusted to reflect the activity and balances per Kaspick & Company and the third party account balances as of December 31, 2014. (p. 3)

Realized and Unrealized Gains and Losses on Investments

Net year-to-date realized losses were \$48, and unrealized losses were \$381,521, for a total loss of \$381,569. (p. 6)

Operating Fund

Total revenue was \$56 more than the budget, and total expenses were \$6,952 less than the budget. The actual net operating deficit is \$245,548 compared to a budgeted deficit of \$252,558. (p. 7)

Note: The Expendable Operating Cash-on-Hand is at 5.0 months, excluding the operating reserve of \$250,000 and the building reserve of \$125,000. (p. 8)

Portfolio Performance

The market value of the portfolio at 1/31/2015 was \$144,753,079. The Total Return for the year to date Pooled Endowment Portfolio through January 31, 2015 was -0.1%. (p. 9-10)

Special Program Funds

Special Program Funds include: Community Leadership Project – funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation; Pathways to Safety – funded by the ACTION Council of Monterey County; Girl's Health in Girl's Hands, funded by the Claire Giannini Fund, the Peggy and Jack Baskin Foundation, the David and Lucile Packard Foundation and the Monterey Peninsula Foundation; and the Center for Nonprofit Excellence funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation.

Total Special Program revenue was \$460,859 and total expenses were \$13,982. (p. 5-6)

Gifts, Pledges, Bequests, Future Funds Greater than \$25,000, and Grants

Total new contributions for the month were \$286,762 including stock valued at \$106,179 from Mr. & Mrs. William and Nancy Doolittle for the Doolittle Fund. (p. 13-15)

Grants to agencies for the month totaling \$150,000 were approved and recorded. A complete list of the grants by grantee is included. (p. 16)

Interfund activity for the month totaled \$9,000. (p. 15 & 16)

Contributions Receivable

We received the second of three payments, in the amount of \$459,332, from the David and Lucile Packard Foundation for the Community Leadership Project. (p. 16)
