COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR MONTEREY COUNTY NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS For the Seven Months Ended July 31, 2015

<u>Assets</u>

Total Assets through 7/31/2015 are \$183,446,543 a 3.59% increase since July 2014, and a 2.30% increase since December 2014. (p. 3)

Charitable Remainder Trusts (CRT) and Charitable Gift Annuities (CGA)

The CRT and CGA funds have been adjusted to reflect the activity and balances per Kaspick & Company and the third party account balances as of December 31, 2014. (p. 3)

Realized and Unrealized Gains and Losses on Investments

Net year-to-date realized gains were \$8,410, and unrealized gains were \$1,505,369, for a total gain of \$1,513,779. (p. 6)

Operating Fund

Total revenue was \$6,022 less than the budget, and total expenses were \$134,490 less than the budget. The actual net operating deficit is \$63,811 compared to a budgeted deficit of \$192,279. (p. 7)

Note: The Expendable Operating Cash-on-Hand is at 6.2 months, excluding the operating reserve of \$250,000 and the building reserve of \$125,000. (p. 8)

Portfolio Performance

The market value of the portfolio at 7/31/2015 was \$147,791,248. The Total Return for the year to date Pooled Endowment Portfolio through July 31, 2015 was 1.9% compared to the Policy Index of 1.4%. (p. 9-12)

Special Program Funds

Special Program Funds include: Community Leadership Project – funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation; Pathways to Safety – funded by the ACTION Council of Monterey County; Girl's Health in Girl's Hands, funded by the Claire Giannini Fund, the Peggy and Jack Baskin Foundation, the David and Lucile Packard Foundation and the Monterey Peninsula Foundation; and the Center for Nonprofit Excellence funded by the David and Lucile Packard Foundation.

Total Special Program revenue was \$771,226 and total expenses were \$308,784. (p. 5-6)

Gifts, Pledges, Bequests, Future Funds Greater than \$25,000, and Grants

Total new contributions for the month were \$587,448, including \$75,000 from the Monterey Peninsula Foundation for the Girls Health Initiative; \$200,000 from the Monterey Peninsula Foundation for the Monterey County Weekly Community Fund; \$50,000 from the David and Lucile Packard Foundation for the Girls Health Initiative; \$80,000 from the David and Lucile Packard Foundation for the Center for Nonprofit Excellence; and \$105,298 from the Pebble Beach Company for the Del Monte Forest Conservancy Fund. (p. 15-16)

Grants to agencies for the month totaling 1,179,365 were approved and recorded. A complete list of the grants by grantee is included. (p. 17-20)

Interfund activity for the month totaled \$500. (p. 16 & 20)

Contribution Receivable

We recorded a contribution receivable for the Monterey County Weekly Community Fund, in the amount of \$200,000, from the Monterey Peninsula Foundation, which is their second year commitment to the MC Gives Campaign. (p. 16)
